NO VISITING CHILDREN UNDER 12 ALLOWED ANYWHERE IN THE HOSPITAL!

Additional Influenza Visitor Restrictions

Intensive Care Unit:

- No children under 12.
- Only 2 family members are allowed to a visit patient at a time. They will be screened for flu like illness (including fever).
- No visitors after 10 pm.

Inpatient Units:

- No children under 12.
- Visitors that have flu like illness should not visit patients.
- No visitors after 10 pm.

Endoscopy, Heart Center, Cardiac Rehab, Radiation Oncology, Wound Care, Infusion Therapy, Same Day Surgery, and other Outpatient Clinics:

- No children under 12(unless the patient).
- One adult can accompany the patient. They will be screened for flu like illness.

Mother Baby/Nursery/Postpartum:

- No siblings or visitors under 12.
- Only 2 adults to accompany laboring patients.
- Only 2 adults can visit post partum patients. They will be screened for flu like illness.
- No visitors after 10 pm unless they have an infant ID bracelet on.
- If laboring patient is admitted after hours 2 designated adults can accompany the patient.

Pediatrics:

- No visitors or siblings.
- Only parents allowed.
